- Must arrive to work at the polling place by 6:00 a.m. and remain there until approximately 8:30 p.m.

QUALIFICATIONS

- Be a United States Citizen
- Be at least 17 years old by Election Day

- Be enrolled in a public or private high school or home school
- Be in good academic standing
- Have permission from a parent, guardian, or legal custodian
- Have permission from your school principal or director
- Be able to participate in at least one virtual training session <u>and</u> one in-person training session
