WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT FORUM, FEATURING  
BRUNSWICK COMMUNITY COLLEGE**

The Brunswick County Democratic Party (BCDP) is hosting a Workforce Development Forum at its headquarters in Bolivia (1420 Old Ocean Hwy) on Saturday, August 12 from 10 a.m.-12 p.m.

This non-partisan event, free and open to the public, is intended to attract job seekers of all ages interested in learning how to get the skills needed for a well-paying career in the trades.

There will be a guided tour of BCC's Myong and Paul Jensen Workforce Development Center (across the street from BCDP headquarters) following the forum, from 12-1 p.m.

Bettina Davidson, Director of Workforce and Trades Education at Brunswick Community College (BCC) will be the featured guest speaker. Other speakers who work in the trades and employers in need of qualified workers will be on hand as well. Attendees will have the opportunity to talk with these experts and ask questions.

Forum attendees will also have a chance to win a free voucher for a workforce/trades class at BCC. Two vouchers will be awarded, one donated by BCC, and one donated by BCDP. The BCDP voucher will be given in memory of Gloria Randall, sister of Timothy M. Randall. Mr. Randall is a member of BCDP and is a former Workforce and Trades Education Director at BCC. He was recently sworn in as a member of the Brunswick County Board of Elections.

Doors for the forum will open at 9:30 a.m. for complimentary coffee and donuts.
