Description	<p>Every precinct needs 3 “judges,” and additional assistants, at the polls. Ideally, there is at least one judge from each party. Having equal representation from both parties increases confidence in the election results.</p> <p>YOU can help ensure this by signing up with our Board of Elections to be a poll worker.</p> <p>For more info., visit: BOE Precinct Officials</p>	<p>Observers are appointed in advance by each political party and may monitor inside the voting site. Each party may assign two site-specific observers and one at-large observer for each voting place. Observers at any site may be relieved after serving for at least four hours.</p> <p>For more info., visit the NC State BOE: State BOE Poll Observers</p>	<p>Greeters establish our party’s presence, distribute sample Democratic ballots, and answer voter questions. They can serve as outside observers/monitors too.</p> <p>Greeters are stationed outside the buffer zone of each voting site, typically 50 feet from the entrance.
