In Uvalde, Texas <u>19 fourth grade students</u> and two teachers were killed by a shooter old enough to buy guns but not beer. It was the <u>30<sup>th</sup> school shooting</u> this year. In 2020, firearms became the <u>#1 cause of death</u> for America's children.

In Dallas, <u>NBA coach Steve Kerr spoke</u> before his team's game. "When are we going to do something," Kerr yelled.
